Dear Constituents:

We need your help! The Dallas City Council will be taking a very important vote that will affect the safety and economics of everyone. Please plan to attend the Dallas City Council meeting on May 28, 2008, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Dallas City Hall, no later than 10:00 a.m. to voice your support for an ordinance that will require the Dallas Police Department to tow any vehicle in which the driver does not have proof of financial responsibility (insurance). This is a State law which the City of Dallas does not adequately enforce currently.

Driving is a privilege which comes with responsibilities, and one of those responsibilities is providing financial responsibility. Those who do not have insurance are forcing others to pay for repairs and medical expenses out of their own pocket. This is a problem which affects everyone, both rich and poor.

Please e-mail the Dallas Councilmembers **IMMEDIATELY** to encourage that they vote to approve this ordinance and take enforcement action on this State law. This will show the entire Council how the citizens of Dallas really feel about this issue. There are still several Councilmembers who are undecided on how to vote.
